	All fish must be caught from shore or surf
Participation	Saltwater fishing license is required
	All participants must be Club members in good standing prior to the
	tournament
	Clubs can fish as many members as they wish
	Please notify Tournament Director of approximate number of members
	attending Sunday morning breakfast
Regulations	RI Fishing/Beach Regulations will be adhered to at all times
	All fish must be weighed on RISAA certified scales. See next page.
	Fish are to be measured from the nose to the tip of the tail
	All fish must be entered into the tournament book by someone other
	than the person or club that caught the fish
Striped Bass	Minimum length: 36 inches
	Right fin must be clipped per RIDEM regulation
	Award: Largest striped bass plaque
Bluefish	Minimum length: None
	Winning entry determined by weight
	Award: Pick of raffle table
Team Trophy	Determined by the total combined weight of:
	Three largest Striped Bass and
	Three largest Bluefish entered by a participating club
	Award: Team Trophy held for one year
Prize acceptance	It is the responsibility of the prize winner to make arrangements for
	prize pick up at the Awards Ceremony if the prize is not claimed in

	Only approved shops with RISAA-Certified scales can be used			
	All entries must be weighed on a RISAA CERTIFIED SCALE			
	The scale must be digital and must give the weight in pounds, tenths and			
	hundreds of pounds, i.e. 9.52 lbs			
	Scales that provide the weight in pounds and ounces are not acceptable			
	The use of a conversion chart is not acceptable
